Dear Happy Valley Primary Families,

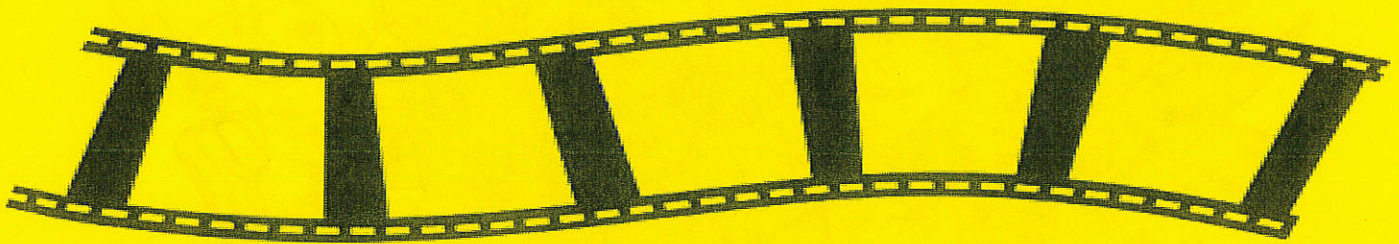

We are excited to bring you this year's annual Family Literacy fair. Our theme will be: **Dinner and a Movie!**

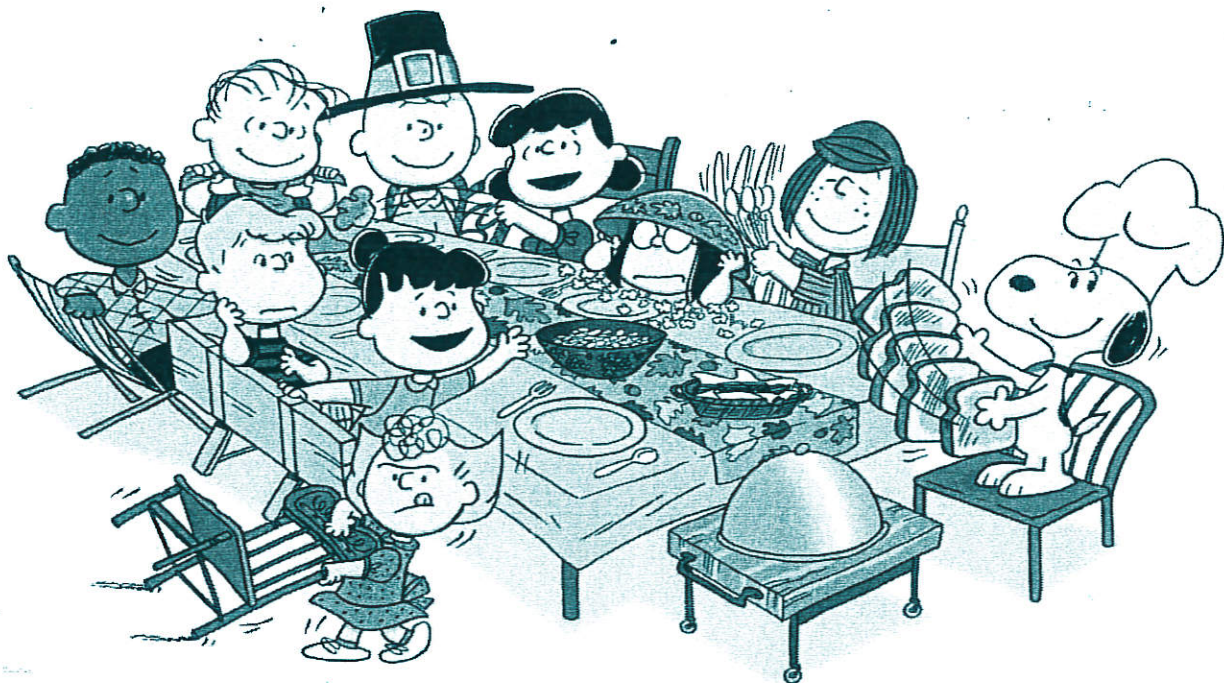
