## *Note from Mrs. Maki, Principal*

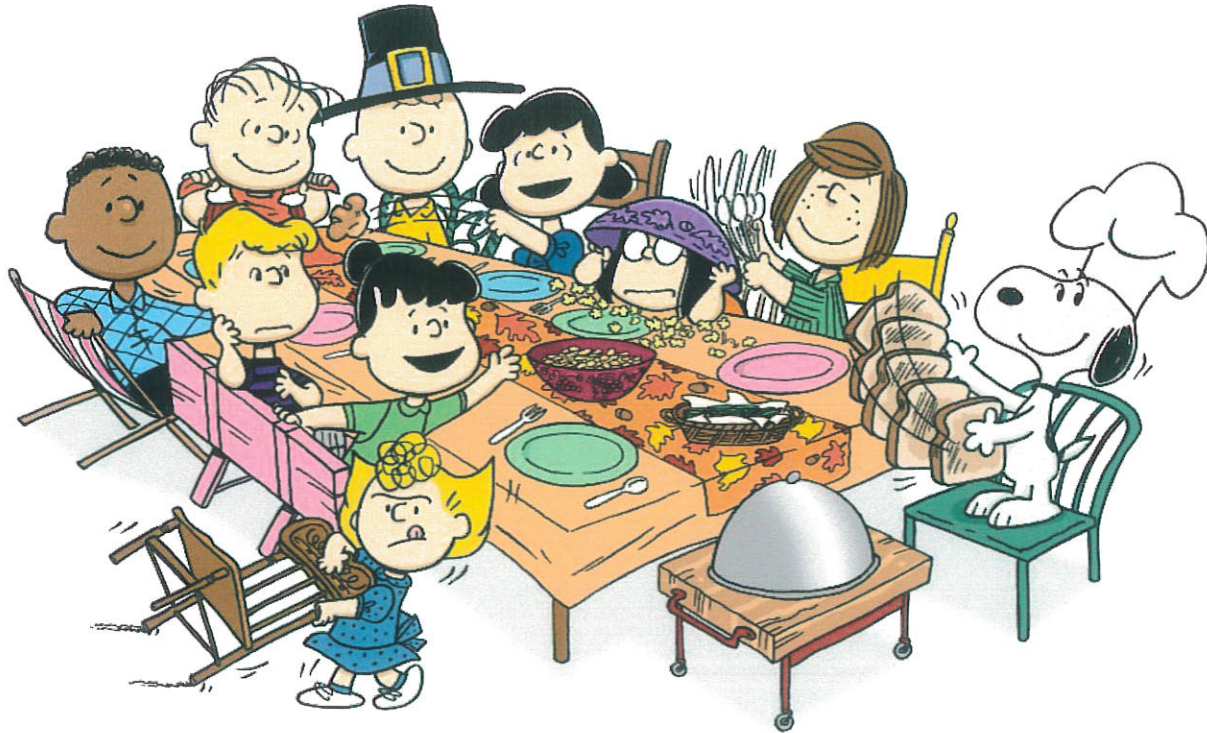
Dear Happy Valley Primary Families,
