The California Education Code Section 48260(a): defines a student as truant when they have been absent without a valid excuse for three or more days or have been tardy to school 30 or more minutes each day for three or more days during the school year.

Absences have a detrimental effect on your child's learning and affect the quality of education your child receives.

Those students who are considered truant may be required to attend Saturday School.

Dear HV Primary Parents;

It is recognized that, at times, there are events which are beyond the control of the student and family that require a student to be absent from school (illness, family emergency, etc.). The Happy Valley Union School District has established a Saturday School program designed to respond to lost instructional time and <u>State Funding</u> due to absences for any reason.

Saturday School allows PRIMARY students the opportunity to make up excused absences, unexcused absences, tardies, get help with concepts that they may be struggling with, make-up missing work, and socialize with friends! Our teachers make Saturday School FUN and FRIENDLY. Snack will be provided.

Your child is *invited* to attend Saturday School on <u>Saturday March 14, 2020</u>. Students are to report to the front office of the Primary School. Saturday School is from 8:00-12:00 p.m. The Happy Valley District Staff and administration hope you will take advantage of the Saturday School Program. *Your help and support are greatly appreciated!*


