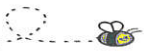

Dear Happy Valley Primary Families,

I would like to thank you for your patience in the absence of this newsletter.. These past couple of weeks have certainly been busy! Which brings me to a conversation I had with a friend the other day. She said to me, "I know my kids *hear* what I am saying, but are they *listening*?"

Some researchers suggest that listening involves a level of critical thinking, which is paying attention to what is being said beneath the words or between the lines. What is the intention behind the words? Why were those words used and not others? What does the tone of voice indicate? What does the body language tell me? What is motivating these words?

This kind of listening is far more active and difficult than the level of listening we generally expect of our children. It requires the listener to put their personal opinions and value judgments on hold for a period of time—to hear other people on their own terms. Some strategies for helping students develop the habit of attentive and empathetic listening include:

- Ask your child to paraphrase what was said to them
- Pay attention to body language
- Wait to speak
- Put yourself in the other person's shoes

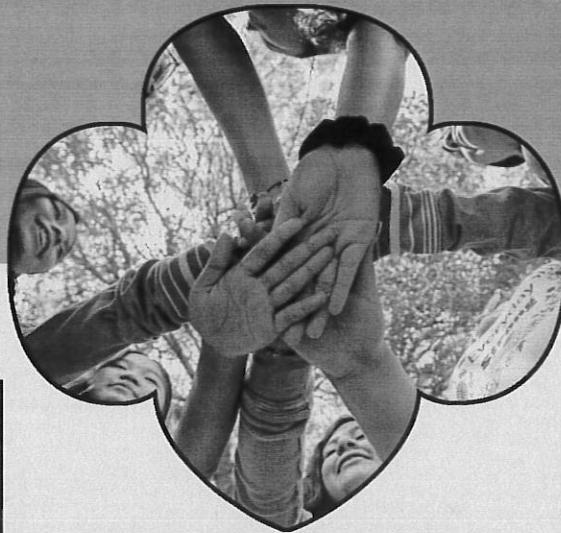
